POLE MOUNT FOR A SATELLITE SPEAKER ON A SUBWOOFER

SAFETY NOTES

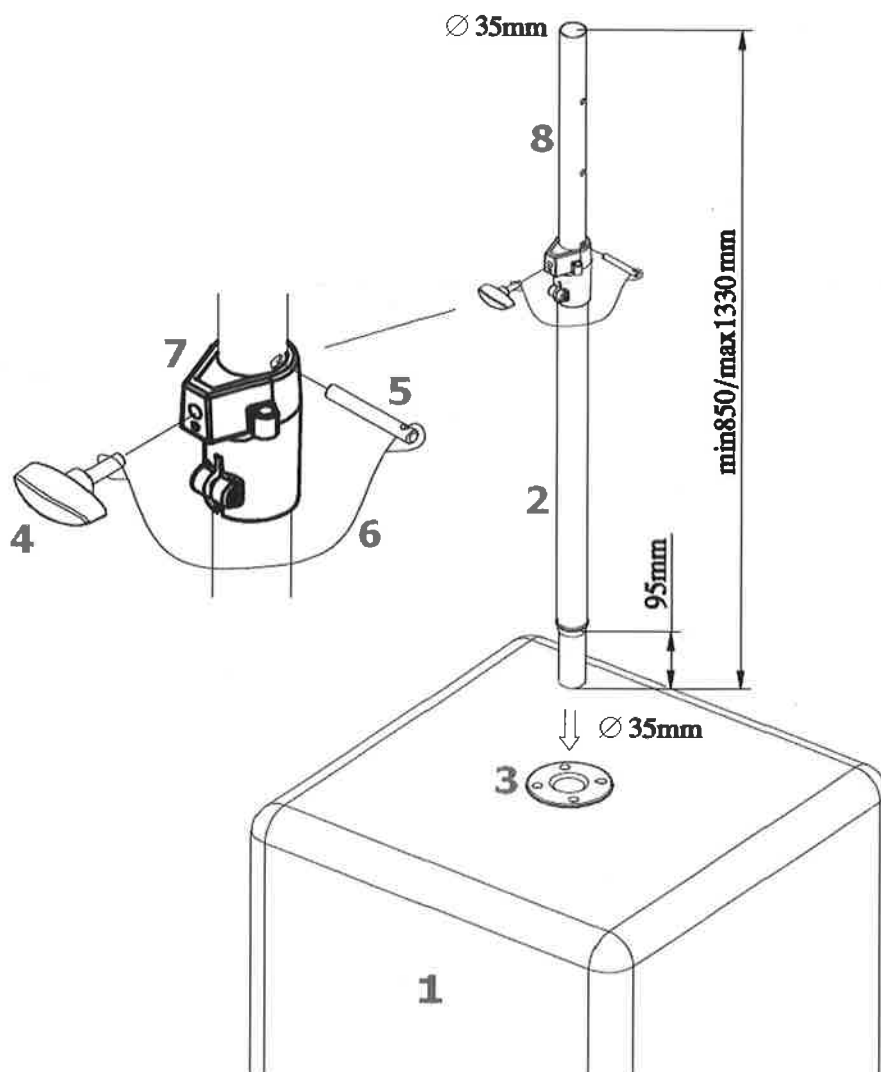
Place the subwoofer only on a flat surface and make sure the locking screw [4] is tightened and the safety pin [5] is inserted. Do NOT loosen the locking screw [4] and remove the safety pin [5] when a satellite loudspeaker (max. weight: 50 kg) is mounted.

USE

- Place the subwoofer [1] stably on a flat surface.
- Insert the lower rod [2] (down to the plastic ring) into the subwoofer flange adapter [3] (not included).
- Remove the locking screw [4] and the safety pin [5] (if previously inserted into a hole of the extension rod [8]).
- Adjust the extension rod [8] height and insert the safety pin [5] into its exposed lowest hole, then let the extension rod go down until it is stopped by the safety pin on the clamp [7].
- Insert the locking screw [4] (through a loop of the safety pin wire [6]) into the clamp [7].
- IMPORTANT: do not raise the bar over 1100 mm.
- Securely tighten the locking screw [4].
- Put the satellite loudspeaker on the extension rod [8].
